Energy Analysis and Greenhouse Gas Inventory for
City of Toledo and Lucas County Operations
(Free & Public Event)**

Toledo, OH - With the help of students at the University of Toledo, city and county officials will soon learn the comprehensive energy consumption and greenhouse gas emissions of their facilities and operations. This information is the first step towards developing an energy and climate action plan for the city and county.

In partnership with the civil engineering department at the University of Toledo, students enrolled in Dr. Defne Apul's graduate level Sustainability Engineering class worked for three months on the project. Students were split into two teams and worked closely with city and county staff. Sectors examined included facilities, vehicles, solid waste, wastewater treatment, water treatment, and traffic signals.
