What is a Green Map:

GreenMap.org is an internationally known mapping tool system used in over 60 countries. Green Maps allow communities across the world to come together in the pursuit of a more sustainable planet by highlighting green projects and engaging citizens in local resources.



How can the Green Map be Used:

- Highlight projects that advance Toledo-Lucas County's social, economic, & environmental well-being
- Showcase local place based achievements
- Provide accessible and easy to use information about resources and community assets to the residents of Toledo-Lucas County
- Discover green, localized resources

How to Add Locations to the Green Map:

1. Open the Green Map and click "Propose a Site" at the top left corner.
2. Select the "Toledo-Lucas County Sustainability Map".
3. Enter the name, description, photos, and icons.
4. Click submit.
5. A TLCSC representative will be in touch with you regarding your submission.

How to Find Local Green Resources:

USING THE FILTER FEATURE:

1. Open the Toledo-Lucas County Green Map.
2. Zoom in on the Northwest Ohio region.
3. Click the filter icon on the top left hand corner of the screen.
4. Select the field you're interested in, then select the sub-field you're interested in.
5. Select the icon you are interested in, you can select multiple icons of interest.
6. Explore green resources near you!

USING THE SEARCH BAR:

1. Open the Toledo-Lucas County Green Map.
2. Zoom in on the Northwest Ohio region.
3. Click the search bar at the top left hand corner of the screen.
4. Type in the icon name you are interested in searching. You can also search for resources by entering in your zip-code or street name of interest.
5. Explore a list of green resources!
